#### Who is invited?

Property owners with land along or near the Matanuska and Knik Rivers or in surrounding communities and those with an interest in river erosion issues.

#### Why do we need an ordinance?

Historically, there has been considerable loss of land and homes due to erosion along the Matanuska River. As the Knik and Matanuska River valleys become more developed, people and property will be increasingly subject to erosion hazards. The Borough has teamed with Alaska Rim Engineers and Agnew::Beck Consulting to prepare a River Erosion Hazard Ordinance for areas along the Matanuska and Knik Rivers. The purpose of the workshop is to review preliminary maps of erosion hazard areas and to discuss options for addressing erosion issues.
